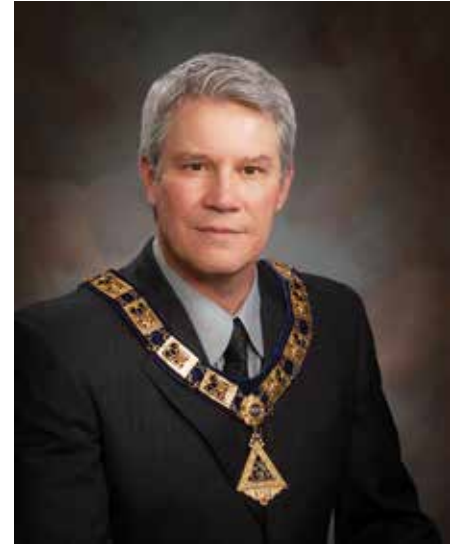

Brothers and Sisters-

***The flag of the United States shall be of thirteen stripes of alternate red and white, with a union of thirteen stars of white in a blue field, representing the new constellation.***

This resolution was adopted by the Continental Congress on June 14, 1777. The resolution was made following the report of a special committee which had been assigned to suggest the flag's design.

The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks has celebrated Flag Day since the early days of the organization and allegiance to the flag is a requirement of every member. In 1907, the BPOE Grand Lodge designated by resolution June 14 as Flag Day. The Grand Lodge of the Order adopted mandatory observance of the occasion by every Lodge in 1911, and that requirement continues. The Elks were instrumental prompting President Woodrow Wilson to recognize the Order's observance of Flag Day for its patriotic expression and on May 30, 1916, President Wilson issued a presidential proclamation establishing a national Flag Day on June 14.



How important the Flag is to our order! The Order of Elks is distinctively American. Linking the destiny of our Order with the destiny of our country we have made its Flag the symbol of the crowning virtue and we have adopted it as emblematic of the cardinal principal of our order – Charity. It is the emblem of the station of our Esteemed Leading Knight and the Lodge Esquire places it in a position of honor at the right of the Alter of Elkdom to open each Lodge Meeting. We recite the Pledge of Allegiance at each Lodge meeting and we present all new members with a Flag as a memento of their initiation. As I write this, I am looking at the one given to me at my initiation in 1979.

As mandated by Grand Lodge, we will be having our Flag Day ceremony on Sunday, June 14th. Over the last few years this celebration has become a signature event for our lodge and one I personally look forward to and am proud to be part of. Each year we honor all the variations of our Flag that have flown over our great Nation. We have utilized the help of our Boy Scout Troop #87, members of 804 that are Veterans and have had guest dignitaries speak during the ceremony. This year's ceremony is sure to be one of the best thanks to the planning and work of PER Hugh Shepherd.

Member participation at all Lodge functions is key to our ongoing success. I encourage each of you to make an effort to attend the Flag Day celebration this year. Bring your family and friends, celebrate your patriotism, your pride of being an American citizen and a member of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks. I promise, you won't be disappointed. Details of this year's event can be found elsewhere in this issue.

Remember and always practice the virtues of our Order, Charity, Justice, Brotherly Love and Fidelity.

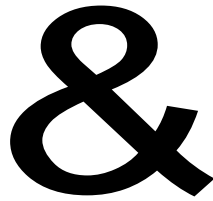
